



FIAC: High School Poster Session (Poster Presentation Guidelines)

1. Technical Specifications

- **Dimensions:** A0 size (0.80 m width x 1.20 m height).
- **Orientation:** Strictly Portrait.
- **Language:** All content must be in English.
- **Readability:** Use large fonts. All text, including captions, must be clearly legible from a distance of 2 meters.

2. Content & Structure

Present your work in a logical sequence using clear headings and subheadings. Your poster must align with the material submitted in your accepted abstract.

Header: Include the full project title and all contributing authors at the top.

Core Sections:

- Brief Introduction & Goals
- Experimental Details / Methodology
- Result and Discussion
- Conclusions and References

Visuals: Provide a concise explanation or caption for every graph, image, and table used.

3. On-Site Instructions

- **Mounting:** Use only the double-sided adhesive tape.
- **Location:** Mount your poster on the board specifically assigned to your code. Posters are grouped by division.
- **Setup & Removal:** presenters are welcome to register and set up the poster on June 11, 2026, from 7:00-8:30 am. All posters must be removed by 5:00 pm on June 12, 2026. Posters left on poster boards after that time will be removed and discarded.

4. Scheduled Times for Poster Presentation

- **Presentation:** All presenters are required to present and engage with viewers in the poster sessions scheduled from 1:15 - 4:30 PM (11 June 2026)
- **Poster Presentation Competition:**
All selected candidates must attend a competition session on June 11, 2026, from 1:30 - 4:00 PM, during which each candidate will present their work for 5-7 minutes, followed by a 3-minute Q&A session.
- **Award Criteria and Announcement**
The winner, first runner-up, and second runner-up will be selected by a poster competition committee, and the judging criteria will be based on content/scientific merit, presentation skills, communication, and the ability to respond to queries. The High School Poster Awards Presentation will be announced around 4:30 PM on June 11, 2026.

5. Registration Fee

The registration fee is 4,000 THB per project submission, which accommodates a team of up to three (1-3) students. For teams exceeding three members, a supplementary fee of 1,000 THB will be applied for each additional student
